The ICA 74th Annual Conference commenced from June 20 to June 24 in Gold Coast, Australia. KACA organized KACA-KASPR Special Joint Roundtable Session, KACA-ICA Research Session, and Networking Dinner on June 22.

2024 KACA-KASPR Special Joint Roundtable Session, Saturday, June 22, 2024, 15:00-16:15.

The 2024 KACA-KASPR special joint roundtable session took place on June 22nd, 2024, from 15:00 to 16:15 during the 74th Annual Conference of the International Communication Association in Gold Coast, Australia. Eight papers were presented, and eight discussants were assigned, one to each paper, to facilitate fruitful discussions on their research. Dr. Mincheol Shin from Tilburg University chaired the session, while Dr. Slgi (Sage) Lee from Pusan National University, Hong-Lim Choi from Sun Moon University, Hanna Park from Sun Moon University, Yeonsoo Kim from the University of Texas at Austin, Yeuseung Kim from Chung-Ang University, Bumsoo Kim from Pusan National University, JongRae Kim from amPR, and Soungyoung Lee from Ubrain Communications served as discussants. The presented papers included:

2024 KACA-ICA Research Session, Saturday, June 22, 2024, 16:30-17:45.

Right after the special joint roundtable session co-hosted with KASPR, the 2024 KACA-ICA research session took place from 16:30 to 17:45. At the beginning of the research session, we had a brief business meeting in which we introduced the KACA executives and ICA subcommittee members. Attendees received updates from the KACA-ICA report and participated in voting for new changes to the membership bylaw. The gathering also marked a membership drive. After the brief business meeting, among the five competitively selected papers, three papers were showcased and discussed in person. Dr. Mincheol Shin chaired the session, and the presented papers included:

"Impact of Disaster-Related Social Media Content on Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder: The Mediating Role of Negative Emotions" and "Young Adults' News Topic Repertoire and Their Citizen Competence" by Zhieh Lor from Ewha Womans University won the top paper and top student paper awards, respectively.

[Membership Update: Important Changes]

The KACA Executive Board has approved changes to the membership year and fees, shifting the start date to May 1st and adjusting rates for all membership levels. This decision was supported by a majority of KACA members present at the KACA business session held during ICA, with 17 out of 18 voting in favor.

Why the Change?

This change aligns membership benefits with the academic calendar, ensuring that a year-long membership covers all four annual conferences:

- ICA (May/June)
- AEJMC (August)
- NCA (November)
- KACA (April)

Previously, members renewing closer to a conference felt their membership only covered the latter half of the year.

Membership Fee Adjustments

In addition to the date change, membership fees will be adjusted effective September 1st, 2024. However, a grace period is in effect until mid-August, allowing members who have not yet renewed to do so at the current rates. Memberships renewed before/during this grace period will be valid until the end of April 2025.

New Membership Fees (Effective September 1st):

- Student: \$25 (previously \$20)
- Regular: \$40 (previously \$30)
- Prime: \$65 (previously \$50)
- Silver: \$95 (previously \$75)
- Gold: \$120 (previously \$100)
- Platinum: \$235 (previously \$200 minimum)
- Lifetime: \$900 (previously \$800)

Additional membership fees, for those beyond the "Regular Member" level, provide enhanced support for KACA's core mission. These funds are vital in nurturing the next generation of communication scholars through graduate student initiatives and sustaining our recently launched flagship publication, the Korean Journal of Communication. Your generous contributions ensure the continued success of KACA and its valuable programs.

A. 멤버쉽 비용 및 기간 변경 안내

KACA-ICA 비지니스 미팅에서의 투표결과를 바탕으로, 올해부터 KACA멤버십 제도가 다음과 같이 수정되었습니다.

- 1) 매년 1월 1일에 시작되어 12월 31일에 종료되던 멤버쉽은, 2024년 부터 매년 5월을 기준으로 갱신이 됩니다. 멤버쉽 기간의 수정은 KACA회원님들의 주요 학회 참여가 5월 이후에 중점적으로 이루어진다는 점을 반영하여, 회원님들의 편의를 돕고자 수정되었습니다. 해당 변경사항과 관련해서는 2024년 ICA에서 bylaw 수정이 가결되었습니다.
 - 이에 따라, 지금 멤버십에 가입하거나 갱신하시면, 2024년 12월이 아닌 2025년 4월 말까지 멤버십이 유효합니다 (2024년 멤버쉽 기간: 가입 시점 2025/4/30). 2025년 멤버쉽은 2025년 5월 1일 부터 다시 시작합니다.
- 2) 또한, 올해 ICA에서는 2024년 부터 멤버쉽 비용과 관련해서 새로운 개편안을 가결하였습니다.
 - 이에 따라 KACA의 연간 회원 비용은 계도기간 이후 2024년 9월 1일을 기준으로 하여 변경(소폭 상승)됩니다. 8월 31일 이전에 멤버쉽 비용을 납부해주시는 회원님들은 이전과 같은 금액으로 멤버쉽 등록이 가능합니다.

- 특별히, 2024년에는 첫 KACA Conference를 Washington D.C.에서 성공적으로 개최하였습니다.
- 한국국제문화교류진흥원(Korean Foundation for International Cultural Exchange: KOFICE)와 함께 제 3회 KACA-KOFICE 컨퍼런스를 개최했고, 리서치 그랜트를 수여했습니다.

A. Notice of Changes to Membership Costs and Duration

Based on the voting results from the KACA-ICA business meeting, the KACA membership system has been revised as follows starting this year:

a. Memberships, which previously started on January 1 and ended on December 31, will now be renewed on an annual basis from May. This change reflects the fact that major conference activities for KACA members occur primarily after May, aiming to improve member convenience. This amendment was passed at the 2024 ICA bylaw revision.

Therefore, if you join or renew your membership now, it will be valid until the end of April 2025 (2024 membership period: from the date of joining to April 30, 2025). The 2025 membership will start on May 1, 2025.

b. Additionally, a reform regarding membership fees starting in 2024 has been approved at ICA.

Consequently, the annual KACA membership fee will increase slightly from September 1, 2024. Members who pay their membership fee by August 31 will be able to register at the previous rate.

KACA serves as the primary platform for Korean communication scholars abroad and represents their voices. Thanks to your ongoing support, interest, and participation, KACA has continued to develop. KACA operates entirely based on the annual fees and donations from our members. Your renewal and membership are essential for the continued success of KACA. If you have not renewed your membership for 2024, please do so by August 15 (2024/5 - 2025/4).

- We successfully hosted KACA research sessions at International Communication Association (ICA), National Communication Association (NCA), Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication (AEJMC) conferences, presenting excellent papers and awarding the Best Paper Award. Additionally, we provide Outstanding Paper Awards and conference travel grants for graduate students and organize social events to encourage interaction among student members.

- Continuing from 2023, we have awarded scholarships to outstanding students through donations to the "Rev. David Tae Yong Cho Memorial Scholarship" fund.
- We have presented the Jae-Won Lee Distinguished Service Award to those who have contributed to KACA.
- In collaboration with Korean academic societies, we have organized KACA research sessions and panel sessions to create networking opportunities.

C. Introduction to KACA (Member Benefits)

For those unfamiliar with the benefits provided to KACA members, here is a brief overview:

- KACA offers networking and job-related workshops for members, helping students successfully complete their studies and establish careers in the U.S., Europe, South America, Australia, and Asia.
- KACA collaborates with various conferences, government agencies, and businesses in the U.S., Korea, and Europe to provide research grants and awards. Members have the privilege of being the first to participate in these opportunities.
- KACA supports participation in major communication and journalism conferences such as ICA, NCA, and AEJMC. Starting this year, KACA will hold its own conference, where members will have priority to participate and present their research.
- The Korean Journal of Communication offers opportunities to publish high-quality, Korea-related communication research.
- Members receive updates on communication and journalism news through various media, with newsletters sent quarterly. KACA also provides information on job markets, call for papers, conference announcements, and events.
